8 ALTERNATE RECIPIENT'S INTEREST

9 IN FUND BENEFITS

10 4. The Participant is required to furnish medical
11 coverage for the Alternate Recipient pursuant to a judgment of
12 this court filed on _____. A copy of the judgment is
13 attached hereto and marked Exhibit "B".

14 5. The Alternate Recipient shall have the right to
15 receive benefits from the Fund, as more specifically set forth
16 herein, so long as (a) the Alternate Recipient meets the
17 requirements of a Dependent as defined by the Rules and
18 Regulations of the Fund ("Rules"), except that the Alternate
19 Recipient need not reside with the Participant to satisfy this
20 requirement, (b) the Participant qualifies as an Eligible
21 Individual in the Fund, and (c) Dependent coverage is provided
22 and paid for on the Participant's account by employer payments,
23 or by self payments from the Participant to the extent allowed
24 by the Rules.

25 6. The Fund shall provide benefits to the Alternate
26 Recipient as a Dependent child of the Participant. Payment of
27 benefits shall be made in accord with the Rules. Any benefits
28 payable to the Alternate Recipient may be paid by the Fund to

1 the Alternate Recipient or to the Alternate Recipient's
2 custodial parent or legal guardian.

3 7. The eligibility of the Alternate Recipient to
4 receive benefits shall terminate on the date specified by the
5 Rules for the termination of Dependent's eligibility, subject
6 to the provisions of this order, unless sooner terminated by
7 court order.

8 COMMENCEMENT OF BENEFITS

9 8. Upon approval by the Trustees of this order as a
10 qualified medical child support order, eligibility for Fund
11 benefits for the Alternate Recipient shall be effective on the
12 first day of the month following the month in which this order
13 is approved and signed by the Court if the Participant is
14 eligible and has Dependant coverage on said date.

15 GENERAL PROVISIONS

16 9. This order is intended to be a qualified medical
17 child support order and is made pursuant to the domestic
18 relations laws of the state of _____. This order
19 relates to and shall affect only the Alternate Recipient's
20 Interest in Fund benefits.

21 10. The Alternate Recipient shall have the right to
22 designate a representative for receipt of copies of notices
23 that are sent to the Alternate Recipient by the Fund with
24 respect to this order.

25 11. Nothing herein shall be construed to require the
26 Fund to provide any type or form of benefit, or any option, not
27 otherwise provided under the Rules of the Fund, except to the
28 extent necessary to meet the requirements of the law relating

1 to medical child support described in Section 1396(g) of Title
2 42 of the United States Code.

3 12. Notwithstanding any other provision of this
4 order, in the event that the Participant, the Alternate
5 Recipient, or another person claiming to derive rights to
6 benefits from any such person, shall make a claim which the
7 Trustees determine to be inconsistent with the terms of this
8 order or with the Rules, the Trustees may forthwith cease
9 payments to all or any persons otherwise entitled thereto under
10 this order pending resolution of said claim and may take such
11 further action as is permitted under the Rules and applicable
12 federal law.

13 13. This court reserves jurisdiction to make all other
14 necessary and proper orders required to carry out the terms of
15 this order.
